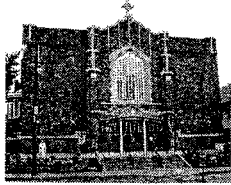


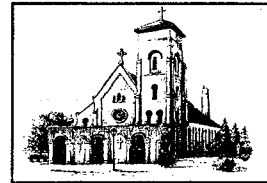

### **OF THE ST. ANNE SOCIETY**

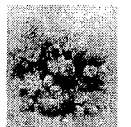
