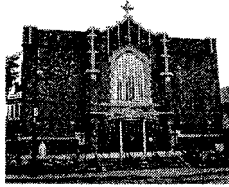

BUILDING PEACE WITH JUSTICE

Today's Gospel invites us to journey with Jesus in a spirit of humility and service to all....with special care for the most vulnerable. Children suffer most from war and conflict in our world. The UN reports that 1/3 of those killed or injured during the conflict in Gaza last year were children and many lost caregivers and siblings. Palestinian and Israeli children's well being and mental health have been severely affected by the continuing conflict in the Holy Land. In his encyclical, *Caritas in Veritate*, Pope Benedict XVI teaches, "Peacebuilding requires the constant interplay of diplomatic contacts, economic, technological and cultural exchanges, agreements on common projects, as well as joint strategies to curb the threat of military conflict."

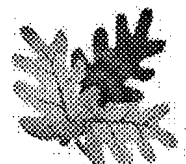
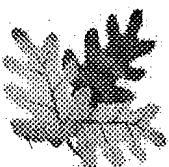
